This Training Course is a 32-hour synchronous and nonsynchronous overview course designed to support classroom educators, tutors, or homeschool parents in applying the principles of Orton-Gillingham and the structure of the English language to their reading and writing programs.

With the completion of an additional 50-hour practicum, trainees will be eligible to apply to the Academy of Orton Gillingham Practitioners and Educators (AOGPE) for certification at the Classroom Educator level, or continue with Part 2 of the Associate Level Training.

Multisensory Instructional Strategies

Multisensory Instruction is a simultaneous and alternative use of visual, auditory, kinesthetic, and tactile sensory modalities that supports the connection of oral language with visual language symbol. Course participants will be instructed in multisensory procedures and strategies for instruction within the classroom.

How This Will Help Your Students?

Multisensory instruction influences learning and is beneficial for all students. It will allow for optimal learning experiences for students of all learning profiles. These multisensory strategies can be implemented in all areas of the general education curriculum and will promote engagement and help create authentic learning pathways for long term learning memory.
