## From the Desk of Mr. Murr...

Based on the latest guidance from the CDC, anyone who tests positive for Covid-19 is required to isolate for a full 5 days from the onset of symptoms, or, if asymptomatic, isolate for 5 days from the date of the positive test. A student who has tested positive for Covid-19 may return to school after five full days as long as the symptoms are resolving and the student has been fever free, without the use of fever-reducing medications, for 24 hours.

If someone in the household tests positive for Covid-19, all family members are required to quarantine for a five full days from the last exposure. The only exception to this quarantine period is for individuals who have received the vaccine AND booster. The CDC recommends testing on Day 5 following exposure. A negative test is not required to return to school. However, if any symptoms are present following exposure, the student is not allowed to return to school until the quarantine time, from symptom onset, is complete.
